

## Meet Fisher-in-Residence

The Museum at Campbell River is offering a wonderful opportunity for local fishermen. As part of the Haig-Brown Festival, the Museum, in partnership with the Haig-Brown Centenary Committee, will host noted fly fisher and author Dennis Reid as a 'Fisher-in-Residence' at the Haig-Brown House from Sept. 23 to 26. Anglers of all ages can book one to two hour time slots to meet with Dennis Reid and discuss all aspects of fishing. Reid has fished and guided for 45 years in salt and fresh water. He has published articles on fishing in more than 50 magazines and is the sport fishing columnist for the *Victoria Times Colonist* and a Field Editor for *Dream House* magazine. He has published three books on fishing with a fourth book slated for this year covering all the best salt- and fresh-water fisheries on Vancouver Island.
