Noted fly fisher Dennis Reid to present talk at C.R. Museum

The Museum at Campbell River will host author and noted fly fisher Dennis Reid for a talk and book signing on Saturday, September 27, from 1 p.m.- 3 p.m. Entitled 'Fly Fishing in the Rivers of Vancouver Island,' Reid's talk will cover all aspects of fly fishing and the various locations for the sport around the Island. Dennis Reid has fished and guided for 45 years in salt and fresh water. He has published articles on fishing in more than 50 magazines and is the sport fishing columnist for the *Victoria Times-Colonist* and a Field Editor for *Dream House* magazine. He has published three books on fishing with a fourth book slated for 2007-08 covering all the best salt- and fresh-water fisheries on Vancouver Island. His articles detail strategy,

tactics, gear and behaviour for all five species of salmon, steelhead (both summer and winter), rainbow and cutthroat trout, halibut, lingcod (including fly fishing for ling), 35 species of *Sebastes* and *Sebastolobus* bottom fish and 27 species of sole and flounder.
